With a massive response given to the tour, a toral of 135 students, escorted by 7 faculty members traveled on a 5 day trip to Kerala from 25th – 30th Sep 2022.

As part of the tour, students visited the MASCO Tea Factory at Vagamon and gained insights into the complete operations of the production management down till the final product. Additionally, they also got to meet the team at the factory to understand the nuances of managing a manufacturing unit and got to experience a real-time experience of all the operational challenges of the factory.



The trip was completely funded by the students themselves and 7 faculty escorts accompanied the group for the tour program.
